# Promoting relating and thinking in the child



How does a child develop the miraculous ability to love, think, communicate, and create, as well as to have selfcontrol and feel compassion for others? Many child-development theories focus on only one part of this puzzle. This social-pragmatic approach develops a child's spontaneous interactions, empathic relationships, thinking, crea-

tive play and problem solving. These are foundations for all social interactions and mastery of academic skills.

This two day workshop is an introduction to DIR<sup>®</sup> Floortime<sup>™</sup> – theory and practice. It will be presented by a speech-language therapist DIR trainer. Hence participants will appreciate the interplay between a child's sensory systems and how it impacts his interaction and communication. Parents and professionals will understand the development of shared meaning and true comprehension. This then organizes behavior and supports self-regulation. We will explore these capacities in both typical and atypical development, and how to facilitate growth of functional emotional capacities.
