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- \*Archetypal movements are the most general and comprehensive motor patterns in our movement system.
- \*They represent genetically coded motor patterns that we use and develop in specific periods in our lives, starting from fetal development.
- \*The archetypal movements represent the neurophysiological basis for the development of the motor sphere, the functioning of the brain, and thus learning.
- \*The goal of the program is to stimulate natural resources for the development and maturing of the reflexes, habits and skills.
- \*Supporting and strengthening the foundations of neurophysiological development in order to stimulate overall intellectual, emotional, and physical development.
